MEMORANDUM FOR ALL SUBORDINATE COMMANDS AND TENANT UNITS

SUBJECT: Buckley Garrison Public Health Directive #21 - 5

1. As the COVID-19 pandemic evolves we must continue to adapt installation policies and preventive actions to appropriately balance protecting base personnel with ensuring continued mission effectiveness and satisfactory quality of life. To those ends, the following guidance is effective 18 June 2021.

2. The following higher headquarters (HHQ) Public Health policies are in effect for Buckley Garrison and tenant units in or near Aurora, Colorado.

a. All commanders/directors are authorized to bring back 100% of non-mission essential personnel. All commanders/directors have the authority to continue to allow teleworking based on mission conditions.

b. Wear of Face Coverings: Individuals that are fully vaccinated (two weeks have passed since the last shot in the series) are encouraged but not required to wear a facemask on base, with the exceptions of the Child Development Centers, Youth Center, and medical facilities. All other individuals must wear masks at all times unless in their private residence.


c. For military personnel, leave outside of the 250-mile radius must be approved at a level no lower than the member's unit commander/director and be in accordance with DoD Force Health Protection Guidance.

3. Installation-wide restrictions outside of those specified above are now removed. However, mission partner leads, unit commanders, and supervisors may direct additional restrictions to manage risk to their missions, personnel, and operational areas, as required. These leaders should execute judgement and risk management principles for situations not dictated by HHQ or Garrison guidance including mask wear and the number of personnel in office spaces, operations floors, or gatherings.

4. Buckley Space Force Base will remain in HPCON B and all personnel should continue to take necessary actions to keep themselves and those around them safe. The Public Health Emergency Officer (PHEO) remains delegated the authority to order medical quarantine. Violations of quarantine or this order may be punishable under Article 92, Uniform Code of Military Justice, and may result in removal from the installation.

5. This policy supersedes any previously published 460 SW or Buckley Garrison public health directives but does not impact any declaration of a public health emergency.
